

Protecting the CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED

- **Environmental Excellence Award:**

Winner of the 2008 National Family Farm Environmental Excellence Award.

- **Manure recycling center:**

We compost and recycle over 50 tons of manure each day.

- **Retail manure blend:**

We bag our own special dehydrated chicken and cow manure blend for home use.

- **Protecting local streams:**

Streams running through our farm have been fenced off to protect the water passing through on its way to the Chesapeake Bay.

- **Bion waste treatment facility:**

PA State approval for a \$7.8 million Bion waste treatment plant which will be the first of its kind in the state of Pennsylvania.



The Chesapeake Bay watershed (drainage basin) extends about five hundred miles north from Suffolk, VA (near Norfolk and Virginia Beach) to the headwaters of Otsego Lake, near Cooperstown, NY, and east from mountain streams near Blacksburg, VA to Berlin, MD.
